

Giving Guide



The principle of “tithing” has biblical origins, donating a tenth of your salary to the Church or other good causes. The following table is designed to help you easily see what this means in terms of a regular **monthly** donation for various levels of income. It also shows the 5% recommended as a donation to the Church of England and 1% to help you scale a donation which feels right for you. (See *overleaf* for weekly rates.)

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The value of donations can be increased by the donor allowing the church to re-claim the tax. If you are a UK taxpayer simply GiftAid your donations; for every £10 given your church receives an extra £2.50.
